In 2016, the airline opened its new \$21 million SkyClub, a 21,000-square-foot lounge that's not only enormous, but stunning. With dramatic 30-foot floor-to-ceiling windows offering views of aircraft and Mount Rainier, the space is consistently ranked as one of the most beautiful airport lounges in the world. Customized Track Rail glass railing with stainless steel handrail from Sightline Commercial Solutions allows for unobstructed views and enhances the light, airy feeling of the space.
