Scope:

Over 18,000 linear feet of ornamental railing was provided for the latest phase of the USTA Billie Jean King National Tennis Center renovation, which features a new (and relocated) main Grandstand, and the redevelopment of the South Campus Tournament Courts. Sightline Commercial Solutions provided Classic Picket Railing, Gridguard Grated Railing, Griprail aisle railing, and Post Rail with SGP glass infill.



Horizontal Classic Picket Railing lines fan entrances, and front of fan seating areas of the new USTA Grandstand facility.



Top and fascia mounted glass railing can be found at the front of fan entrances and aisles at the new Grandstand.



Top mounted horizontal picket railing line fan entrances to South Campus seating with Gridguard railing bordering bleachers.



Side mounted Gridguard Railing with grated infill lines the back of the seating area on the USTA South Campus seating bleachers.



Anodized aluminum horizontal picket railing surrounds ADA seating areas at the newly redeveloped USTA South Campus.



USTA's South Campus fan seating areas utilize Gridguard grated railing attached to brackets stud welded to the raker beams.
