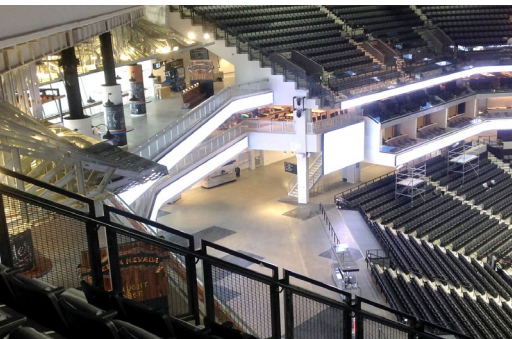

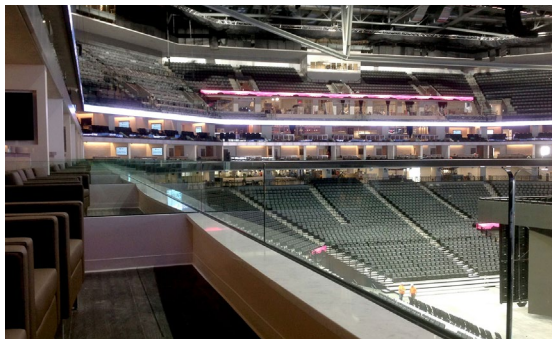

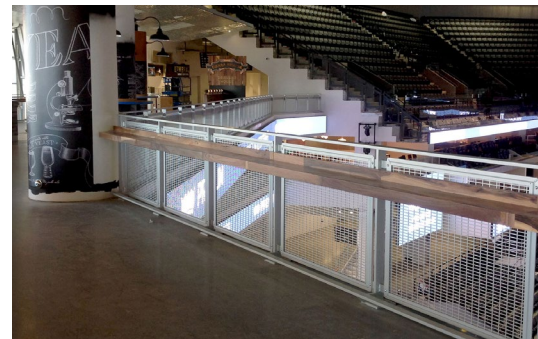

It boasts nearly 3 miles of architectural railing weaving through its concourses, seating bowls, suites, and lofts. Custom perforated infill enhances loft overlook railings, while drink railings along walkways offer additional comfort and amenities. Track Rail glass railings ensure clear views of court action, and ornate railings grace premium areas, lending mystique and intrigue to the venue.



Upper fan seating area utilized painted aluminum railing with perforated infill.



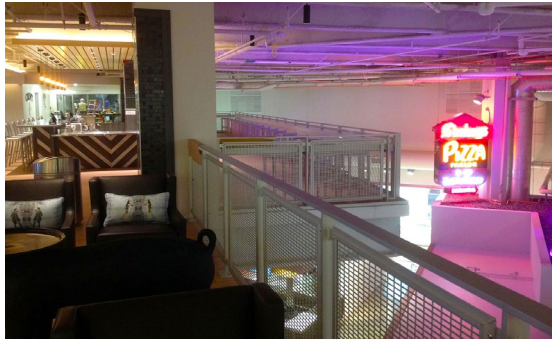
Track Rail™ glass railing surrounding the luxury "Loft" theater box type seating areas.



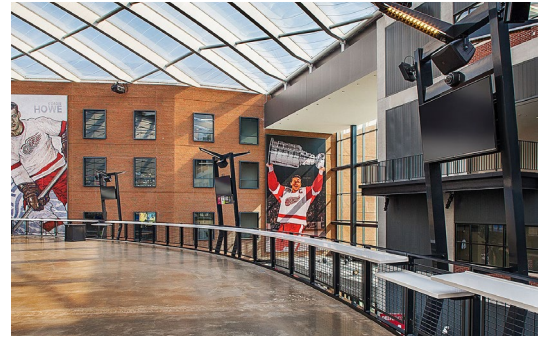
Aluminum perforated panel railing with custom drink rail and spill angle rail.



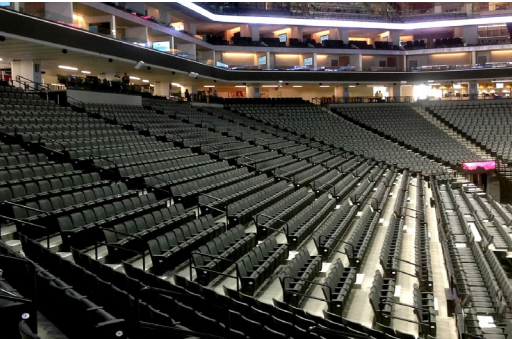
Glass railing suite dividers and in front of seating provide a clear view.
