The Witte Museum is where nature, science, and cultures collide in San Antonio. It is the most-visited museum in the area and brings in thousands of visitors per year. This project required 120+ linear feet of Track Rail, our base shoe mounted glass railing system. This particular railing design called for a low-profile, 2-1/2" x 1/2" white oak top cap.
