To address two primary issues – the need for better acoustics and more storage – Sightline Commercial Solutions supplied the Center with a custom Bravado® Acoustical Shell. The state-of-the-art system consists of mobile towers and ceiling panels made of curved surfaces specifically designed to reflect sound energy towards the audience to create a resounding auidal experience for both the audience and performers. Making the UT Tyler system particularly unique is that the mobile acoustic towers are designed to be detached from their respective bases and hoisted into the fly space.
